I've tabbed this in standard tuning, and for all I know it could be easier in other forms, but I hate detuning my guitar so that everything is a half step down and such. You can play it like this (like I do), but trust me it will require mad pinkie stretching.

Tuning: EADGBE - standard tuning  
 Intro: /Verse: This goes on in the background

Chorus: Heavy Distortion, power chords

Then play the intro/verse section again.

Then the chorus once more.

Then this:  
 This is supposed to be played by the bass, but it works just

as well on the guitar. It is played quietly with no distortion, turn your tone down so your guitar sounds more like a bass.

"wait...wait for me"

still singing "wait for me" but the power chords come in they are off beat, this is the EXACT strum pattern, listen to the song to get it right, it sounds weird at first but once you figure out which beats to stress you'll get it

Also play this PALM MUTED.

then more power chords, easy beat though just simple strumming "even though..."

then go back to CHORUS to finish the song off!
