The lights of the city are the stars on the ground.

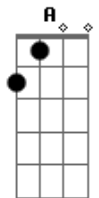
I may not be a Quaalude living in a speed zone,

But I could be restful. I could be someone's home,

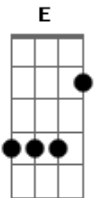
If I fell down, and I fell down, down.

Now all the stars have fallen.

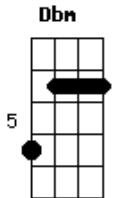

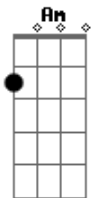

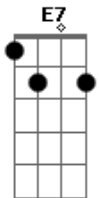
