On the ^Cbonnie, ^{Am}bonnie banks of loch lomond.

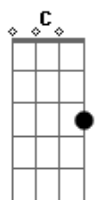
'twas then that we parted, in yon ^Cshady ^{Am}glen

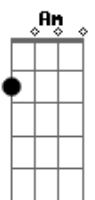
The wee ^Cbirdies ^{Am}sing, and the ^Fwildflowers ^Gspring

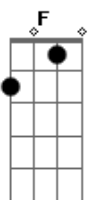

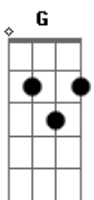

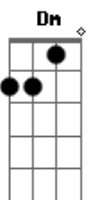
