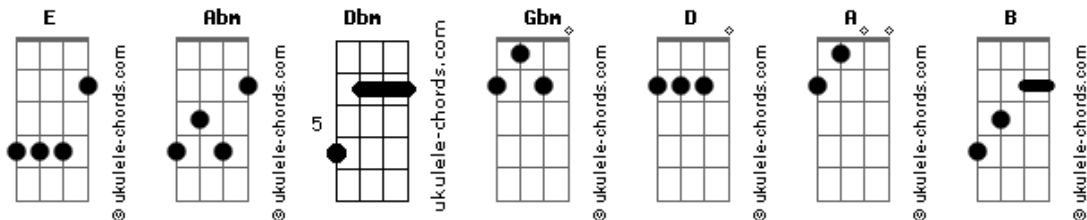
The sailors say Brandy you're a fine girl (you're a fine girl)
