- E**: Open strings (E4, C4, G4, E4)
- Am**: 2nd fret (E4, C4, G4, A4)
- A7**: 2nd fret (E4, C4, G4, A4) with 7th fret on the A string (A4)
- Dbm**: 1st fret (D3, B2, F3, Db3)
- Gb7**: 3rd fret (G4, Bb4, F4, Gb4)
- B7**: 4th fret (B4, D5, F#5, G5)
- D**: 2nd fret (D4, F#4, A4, D5)
- C**: 3rd fret (C4, E4, G4, C5)
- Abm**: 4th fret (Ab4, Cb5, Eb5, Ab5)
- G**: 3rd fret (G4, B4, D5, G5)
