The music of the years gone by.

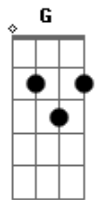
Sometimes I wonder why I spend the lonely night

And I am once again with you.

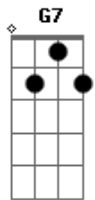
But that was long ago; now my consolation

the memory of love's re - frain.

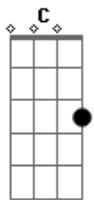
