Pushed around by the wind and the worthless little thing

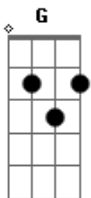
But the world can feel the changes of a butterfly's wings

And so that crooked burning cigarette rolling on your tongue

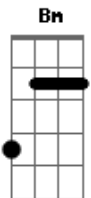
Will leave be tweeds before your flowers when yet have sprung

Will there be weeds or wildflowers when you're done

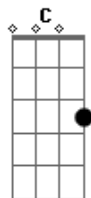
