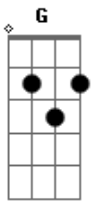
And even though you needed me, it was clear that I could not

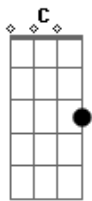
Now life devalues day by day

slipped away.

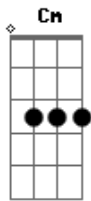

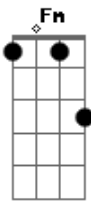

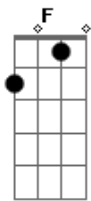
