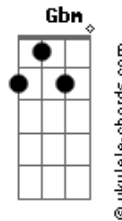
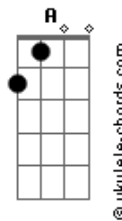
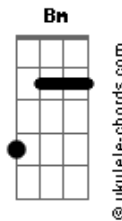
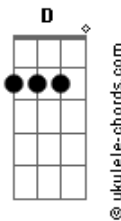
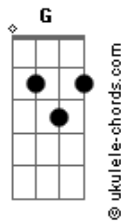
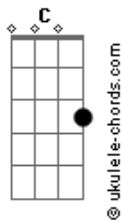
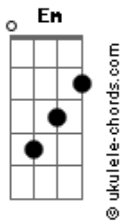
Em
