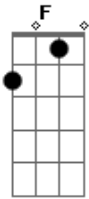

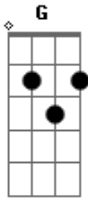

 (G C D C) (2x) (G C D C) (G)

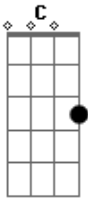
