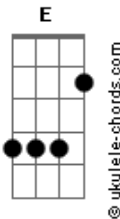
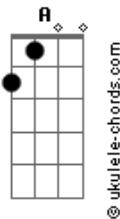
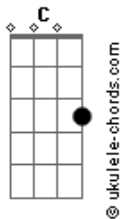
Same thing when the singing begins:
