Intro: It layers itself with three parts, rhythm, lead riff, and solo

Pt.1  
(Other Gutiar slides on low **E** with distortion)  
Weird fingering here, but this is how It's done in the video  
(NOTE: These are 13's and 10's, not 3's and 1's etc.)

Pt. 2 (Rhythm continues)  
MAIN RIFF: Distortion, pay close attention for strumming here

Pt. 3  
All other guitars continue  
Solo Guitar:(Hold bend) (Hold Bend)

VERSE  
Palm Muting: Notes in aren't needed, but it gives some kick  
Play twice, then Transition to Chorus

TRANSITION:"We won't hesitate.."  
Guitar 1: Clean

Gutiar 2

CHORUS: Here comes the Main Riff again

VERSE 2: Rhythm guitar is same as 1st Verse, Lead Guitar spices  
it up a bit here  
Rythm

This synth is under everything, not important at all

2nd time Lead guitar

TRANSITION 2:  
Guitar 1: Slight Distortion

Gutiar 2

CHORUS 2: Same as 1st, but play 2x

2nd time Rhythm gutiar from intro plays

BRIDGE: Pre-solo breakdown. Not much guitar here but I'm pretty sure  
the guitar just goes with the bass under the piano and what-

have-ya  
Palm muted

SOLO: I'd say this is a pretty awesome solo, it's quick at parts,  
and I hope this tab is clear enough so you can get it perfect.

TRANSITION 3  
Guitar 1

Sustain with wah and whammy bar

LAST CHORUS: This is the Breakdown  
"Life is a highway" Fill on 4th time:  
"You're goin' my way" on 4th time again:

OUTRO: Main Riff comes back  
There's also a 2nd solo in here, the rest of the parts continue  
underneath it, then all the guitars fade to the end

This Riff continues, and both Rhythm and Lead play until fade

This is a fill at 3:58, not very important  
but it's there so I tabbed it
