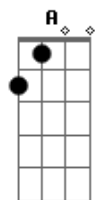


# Ray Charles - Busted

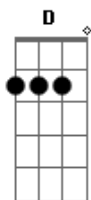
Tom: D

 i'm broke ,no bread,i mean like nothing

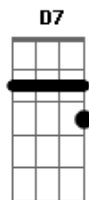
