(C Cm G C Eb G)

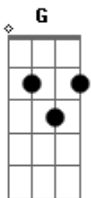
Terceira Parte:

But you vote to the right

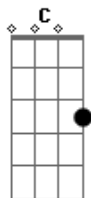
Quarta Parte:

Final: G C G C D C G

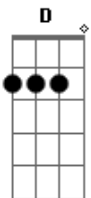
