Ohhhh Johnny you make me so proud!

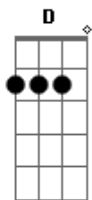
D

I said very politely that I didn't want to work in no factory.

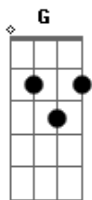
(Pausa) Em G

Because I've see all I wanna see, and more.

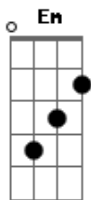
