 To take what happened to us

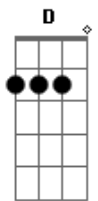
To Write down everything

 Three days in Rome

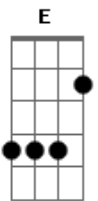

 Three days in Rome

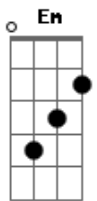
