Riff 1:

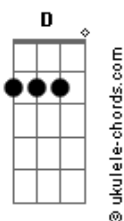
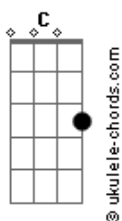
Play this once for the intro and then six times during the verse.
