| [The second and third verses are slightly different; if you want to get it exactly right, just listen to the recording.] [An equal sign (=) is a hammer-on; 2 means quickly hammer-on from 0 to 2.] [Accents are on the 1st, 4th, and 7th eighth notes of each measure; those are usually played by the thumb. (In the recording, you can barely even hear the non-accented notes.)] [Actually in G; capo at the 3rd fret.] | <pre>[It's a judgement call as to whether the E7's are actually E's or E7's.
