Turning 21"

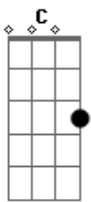

I remember it all too well

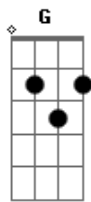

"I'll get older, but your lovers stay my age"

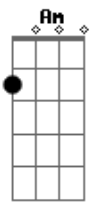

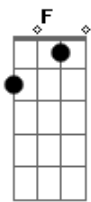
