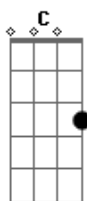

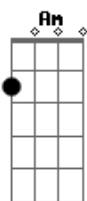

You know I miss you

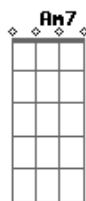
