Tom: G

[Intro/Verse]

It's not exactly what he's playing but just mess around with something like this during the verse and you should sound good. If you want to strum just strum a G and hammer on the 2nd fret on the D string every once in a while.

Third line of the verse (The Chemicals that make her laugh... Even though her son is gone... She just wants to feel something... etc.) it change to a D then Back to a G, something like this:

[Verse 5]

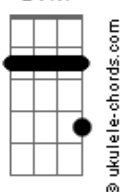
Over the water, hmm

[Chorus 2]

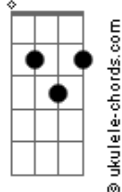
And in the end, she chose cocaine
