Don't you sit in front of me <sup>F</sup> <sup>C</sup>

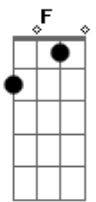
And wait for me to talk <sup>G</sup>

 I wish I could say the same for you <sup>G</sup>

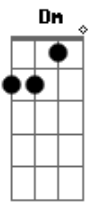
