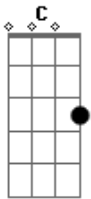

Can't you see, Sister Morphine, I'm trying to score.

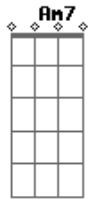

stained red.

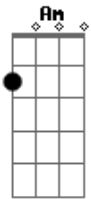
