PATTERN A:

I would...

...rather not go back to the old house...I would repeat Pattern A once

LEAD IN TO PATTERN B:

rather not go back to the old house

PATTERN B:

there's too many bad memories

there's too many memories there

repeat pattern A twice ("When you cycled by...", "And you never knew...")

lead in to pattern B ("Are you still there?")

pattern B ("Or have you...")

repeat first two bars twice (or so)

play

repeat first two bars many times (about four?)
end on slowly
