 Your shoes and shour shirt all just right

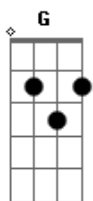

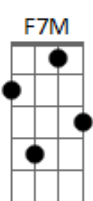

 Fingers so clumsy, voice too loud

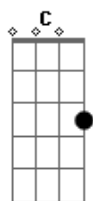
