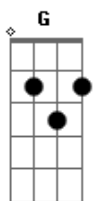

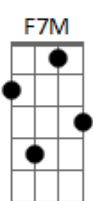

 Fingers so clumsy, voice too loud

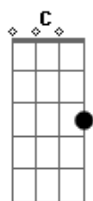
