Verse rhythm pattern:

Bm Em A7 D G7 Gb7 Bm

Chorus rhythm pattern:

G D A7 D G D A7 D Da

Verse sequence:

Bm Em A7 D  
 I fell into the ocean and you became my wife  
 G7 Gb7 Bm  
 I risked it all against the sea to have a better life  
 Em A7 D  
 Marie you are the wild blue sky, men do foolish things  
 G7 Gb7 Bm

You turn kings into beggars and beggars into kings

Chorus sequence:

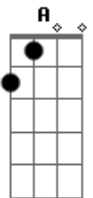
G D A7 D  
 Pretend that you owe me nothing and all the world is green  
 G D A7 D  
 (Bbm)  
 We can bring back the old days again when all the world is green

NOTE: The Bbm leads you back into the verse from the chorus.

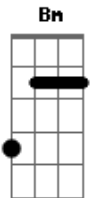
Solo sequence:

The song changes key to C minor for the clarinet solo. The Da and Bbm are replaced with to lead you into C minor. The solo sequence is played exactly the same as the verse sequence except that is moved up 1 semitone (1 fret). Stay in C minor for the last verse.

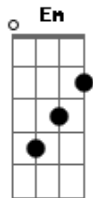
