

Tom Waits - All The World Is Green

Tom: **A**

Verse rhythm pattern:

Bm **Em** **A7** **D** **G7** **Gb7**

Chorus rhythm pattern:

G **D** **A7** **D** **G** **D** **A7**
Bbm

Verse sequence:

Bm **Em** **A7** **D**
I fell into the ocean and you became my wife
G7 **Gb7** **Bm**
I risked it all against the sea to have a better life
Em **A7** **D**
Marie you are the wild blue sky, men do foolish things
G7 **Gb7** **Bm**

You turn kings into beggars and beggars into kings

Chorus sequence:

Bm **G** **D** **A7** **D**
Pretend that you owe me nothing and all the world is green
G **D** **A7** **D**
(**Bbm**)
D Da We can bring back the old days again when all the world is green

NOTE: The **Bbm** leads you back into the verse from the chorus.

Solo sequence:

The song changes key to **C** minor for the clarinet solo. The **Da** and **Bbm** are replaced with to lead you into **C** minor.
The solo sequence is played exactly the same as the verse sequence except that is moved up 1 semitone (1 fret). Stay in **C** minor for the last verse.
