Chorus

"Gimme gimme one more" "Gimme  
 gimme one more" FILL

 NEXT VERSE:  
 GUITAR 1 (RHYTHM)

Guitar 2 (lead)

Then the next part is the verse before the chorus, it's played the same as it is played the first time, except with a different ending to the chorus:

Guitar 1

"One more MegaaaaaaaaaByte" #\  
 Guitar 2 Pick  
 scrapes the E and A string here

The middle part:

guitar 1 (Rhythm)

play the notes in brackets only the second time around .

Bend this note up gradually release the palm muting.

Guitar 2 (Funky part)

1st Screech

Funky part again after this, then:

2nd Screech

The next lead part is the same idea as before, but starting in a Higher key.

"I need MORE-ME--MO-  
 The dots after the notes  
 with a palm mute (staccato)

Repeat (This time no harmonics)
