 For so long as I've gone and so far I've wandered

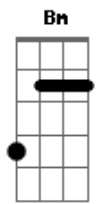
The evening star has shone thus far

 You're home again, on roofs the rain

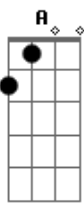
