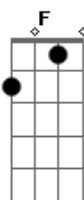

I'll leave this old world with a satisfied mind.

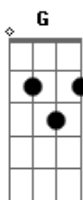

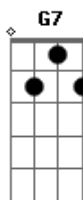

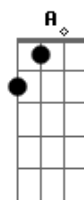
